Since June 2009, ASSCAT has been developing a new project in collaboration with immigrant associations in Catalonia. Six talks have already taken place and we have received an excellent feedback from the target community .

ASSCAT has contacted immigrant associations in order to organize together talks about Hepatitis B and C. These talks include an specialist in the field and people suffering from these diseases. The audience is informed about the risks of contracting hepatitis viral infection, different ways of infection and how to prevent them, the effect of the disease on personal relationships, work, social life, etc...Days before each talk a survey is carried amongst the target group in order to measure the degree of knowledge about viral hepatitis.

This project aims to:

Interlink partner associations in order to optimize resources, share common problems and objectives and work together to find solutions.

Inform, train and support immigrants and their families.

Create awareness amongst immigrant population about the significance of this disease.

Objectively and clearly inform about the risks of transmission of hepatitis B and C in order to maximize prevention and early diagnosis.

Report objectively and clearly about the effects of suffering viral hepatitis, not only in the physical sense but also with a psychological, familiar, social and occupational perspective.
